



## Club Statement

Dear Parents, Players, Coaches and fellow Committee members

Thank for your ongoing patience on a number of fronts. As you will appreciate the impacts of Covid 19 basically stopped all activities not just sporting, in their tracks when we went into lockdown. You may recall that the club took the decision to suspend all football activities before lockdown was announced as it was clear to the Committee what was about to follow given events around Europe

Now that the Government and FA have announced we can look to recommence, I am pleased to say that subject to a final "Go-NoGo" decision on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> August, we will look to commence training from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August. I want to thank the Clubs Committee who have been working hard behind the scenes in preparation of this – there are many things that the Club have had to get ready such as risk assessments to updated club conduct forms as well as getting prepared for the signing on process too that will ensure coverage for insurance relating to injuries etc.

Also, in the midst of all that, we have spent well in excess of £1000+ on PPE such items as hand sanitisation, gloves and masks for all team managers to allow them to deal with injured players etc. We need all our Players and Parents to play their part in the fight against Covid 19 to ensure we don't go backwards with suspension of football so please play your part. We will be looking at giving each player a playing bib for training, that will be their bib to use at all times when needed. All equipment will be sterilised before and after training and matches. Below are a few things we are currently working on:

- Signing on Fees this season it will be reduced to £15 from the usual £25, we understand that as the club face less fees in some areas, these are negated by the ongoing increase in PPE costs that we will need to factor in this season but we also know this is a difficult time for many families and we are here to assist as much as we can. Please speak to your team manager if you are having financial issues and they can put you in touch with one of the committee members
- Subs will remain at £3 per week we are currently looking at an online method for subs to be paid so we
  can keep it contactless moving forward we are not looking to take cash payments for subs. We will
  commence without collecting subs for the first week or two whilst we finalise the new approach to subs
  payments
- Kits When the season commences, all players will be given their own kit to wash and take home etc each week. Please can you ensure that they are kept as white as possible when you are washing them
